**DESCRIPTION:** 

The fuses in the fuse box in the operator's cab may be installed different whom those indicated on the nameplate. In this case, rectify them according to this **PARTS & SERVICE NEWS.** 



## 2. Correction procedure

- (1) Open the rear cover in the operator's cab.
- (2) Remove the two mounting screws of fuse box A (BT3), and reinstall it inversely (Fig. 1 and Fig. 2).



Confn-m that the capacity of each fuse can se lox A now conforms to that on the fuse nameplate (Fig. 3) stuck to the back of the cap wer.




