**DESCRIPTION:**

**1. Introduction**

With the above wheel loaders, the top fan guard mounting plate might be broken by the vibration at high hours. In that case, replace mounting plate on radiator shroud to follow this service news.

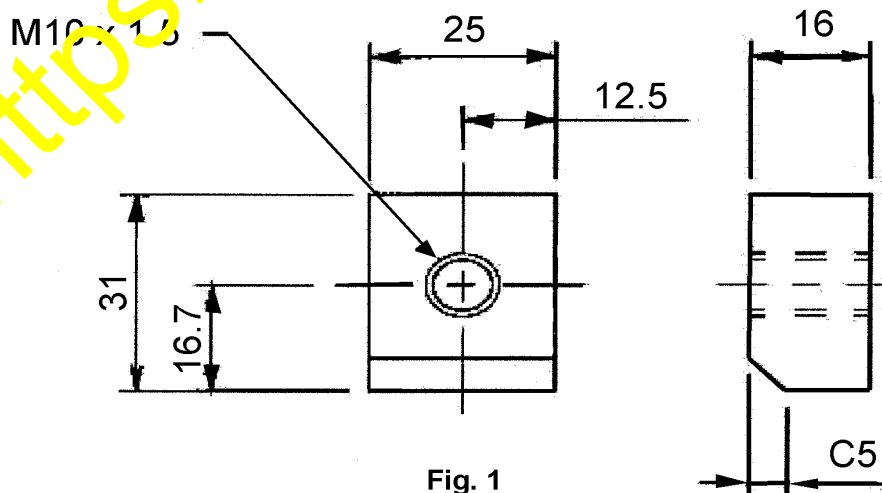

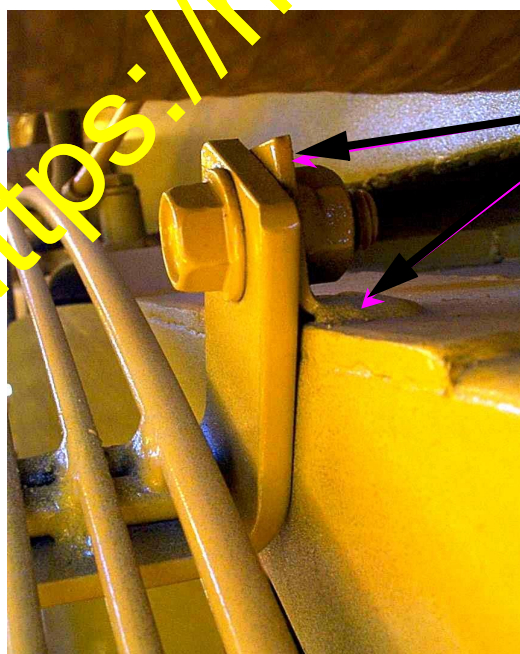
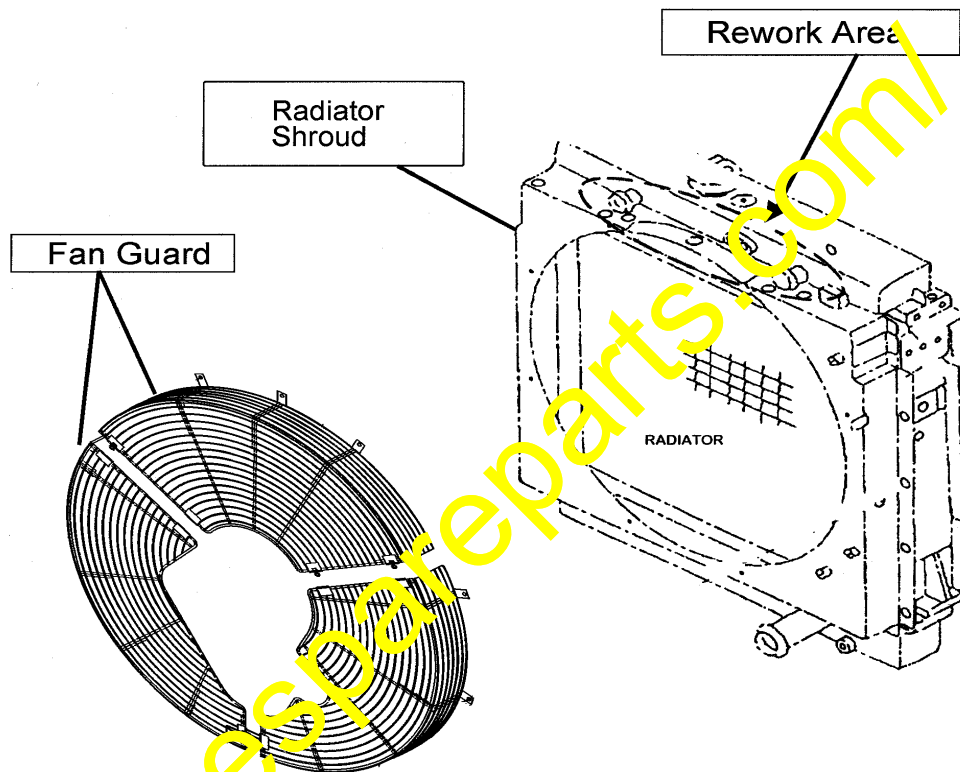

### 3. Modification procedures

1. Uninstall fan guards from shroud.
2. Remove broken plates from radiator shroud  
(LH and RH, 2 places)

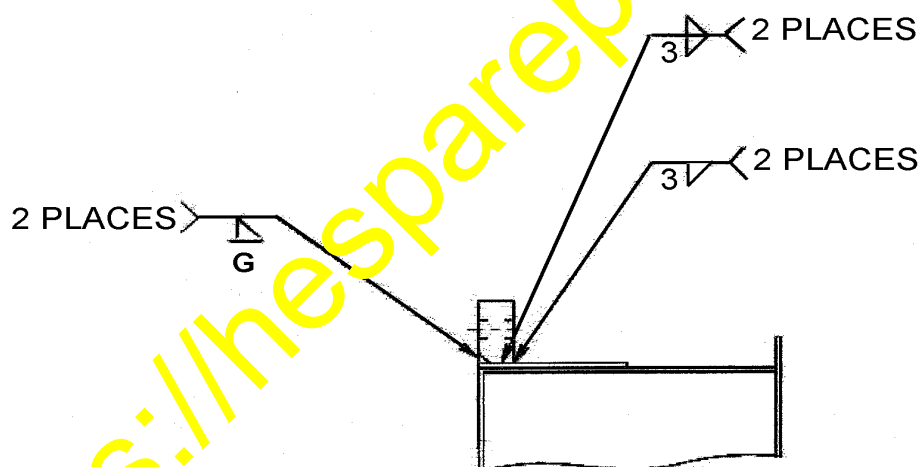
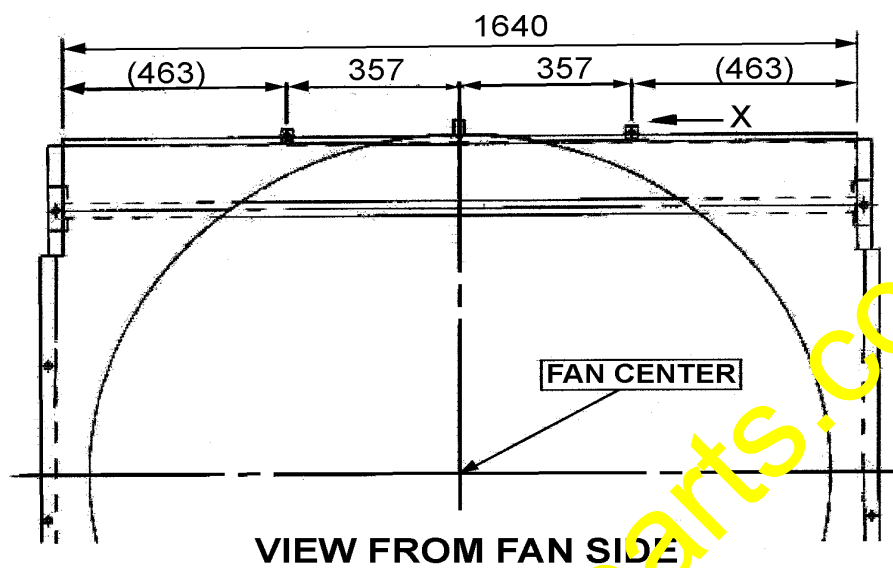


Remove the L-shape brackets,  
LH & RH from Radiator shroud  
and grind removed area to  
smooth.  
Photo shows LH side.

3. Weld new mounting block

Weld new seats as shown below.

Fan guards may be used for seat positioning.



4. Paint reworked area on block

5. Install fan guards
