MACHINE PREPARATION

- 1. Park the machine on a flat level surface; lower the work equipment to the ground. Shut off the engine and cycle the controls to remove any residual hydraulic pressure from the work equipment circuits. The parking brake switch on and block any tracks or wheels if necessary.
- Remove the key from the ignition switch until the repairs are complete. Place a tag on the steering 2. controls advising: "This machine is being repaired. It should not be started or moved for any reas n until the tag is removed by the person doing the repairs."


