## **DESCRIPTION**;

#### 1. Introduction


When the optional ECSS is not installed leaving the harness connector for the ECSS unconnected, a cap needs to be installed to the harness connector to prevent entry of water. However, there is a possibility that some of the above listed machines were shipped without installing such a cap and consequently, you are kindly requested to check the connector section at opportunities such as of rendering periodical services, and if the cap is found not installed install it following the procedures outlined in this Service News.

## 3. Modification Procedure

Inspect the front harness connector (CNF13) located at L.H. inside of the front frame, to check whether the cap, harness (421-06-21310) is installed or not. (It is not necessary to check the machine with the ECSS.) If not installed, install the cap and fix it to the harness with the band.



**X** If the connector CNF13 is left unused without installing the harness cap and if water enters in the harness, malfunction of bucket leveler, boom kick-out, etc. may result.
